## Update - Several Draft Regulations of Minister of Communication and Informatics to Simplify Licenses and Regulations

The Ministry of Communication and Informatics just posted several draft minister regulations as the implementation of the government's plan to simplify licenses and regulations. Among other things, the drafts are as follows:

### 1. On the Provision of Content Services in Cellular Mobile Networks.

It combines several existing regulations on the Provision Of Content Services In Cellular Mobile Networks And Wireless Local Fixed Networks With Limited Mobility.

The substance of the draft regulation would cover, among other things:

- a. The provision of content services
- b. Content
- c. The mechanism of the provision of content services in cellular mobile networks
- d. User protection
- e. Licenses
- f. Sanctions

### 2. On Internet Protocol Television Services

It combines several existing regulations on the Internet Protocol Television Services.

The substance of the draft regulation would cover, among other things:

- a. IPTV services
- b. Procedures and requirements for the provision of the IPTV services
- c. Approval for the provision of the IPTV services
- d. Sanctions

The draft regulations can be downloaded from the website. The public is welcome to provide comments on the drafts from 24 until 30 November 2016.
